1. To transfer the data through online systems. In this case live consultation data will be transfer by the doctors on sight and the doctor on main lab will view every examination they are taking up.
2. Doctors at sight can transfer selected cases to consultants of which they are not sure of giving any advice. In this case no online data back-up is taken-up by the systems.
